

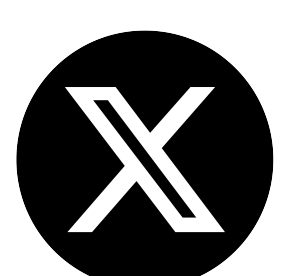

In these roles, Dr. Swartz has been an advocate for diversity and inclusion. Throughout her career, Dr. Swartz has found that saying no is crucial in science, allowing scientists to maintain focus and avoid becoming overwhelmed. This selectivity leads to more meaningful contributions and greater strides in advancing knowledge.
