

Regulation for the 2023 EuPA Breakthrough in Proteomics Award

Aim of the award

With the EuPA Breakthrough in Proteomics Award, the European Proteomics Association (EuPA) aims to reward a discovery that has transformed the frontier of knowledge in proteomics and has a major impact on science, technology, and society.

Eligibility

To be eligible, the applicant must fulfil the following criteria.

- The applicant must be a member of a EuPA member society.¹
- The applicant must not have been awarded the EuPA Breakthrough in Proteomics Award in the 3 previous years (2020-2022).

Selection procedure

The EuPA Awards Committee members will score the application based on the answers provided in the form and using the following criteria:

- Originality
- Accessibility
- Cost efficiency
- Applications in proteomics and impact on other fields (medical, clinical, etc.)
- Related publications

Award presentation

The EuPA Breakthrough in Proteomics Awardee will receive a prize of €1,000, will be honoured with a plate with name and recognition, will be invited to give a short talk during the upcoming 2024 HUPO-EuPA conference closing event and will be granted free registration fees (sponsored by the congress organisation).
