

Regulation for the 2023 EuPA Technology Award

Aim of the award

With the EuPA Technology Award, the European Proteomics Association (EuPA) aims to recognise the outstanding contribution of a private company to the development of an innovative proteomics technology.

Eligibility

The application is open to any company, regardless of its size, that has introduced a new proteomic technology in the last year and has broad application prospects. However, a company which has received the EuPA Technology Award in the 3 previous years (2020-2022) is ineligible.

Selection procedure

The EuPA Awards Committee members will score the application based on the answers provided in the form and using the following criteria:

- Originality
- Applications in proteomics, impact on other fields (medical, clinical...) and longevity
- Publications using the technology
- Green potential (energy efficiency...)
- Cost efficiency

Award presentation

The EuPA Technology Awardee will be honoured with a plate with name and recognition and will be invited to participate at the career session organised by the Young Proteomics Investigators Club (YPIC) during the upcoming 2024 HUPO-EuPA conference.
